She is the Governmental Affairs Officer for the Metro Wastewater Reclamation District in Denver, heading the District's Governmental Affairs and Water Quality Division. Barbara has been with the Metro District for 15 years and is responsible for all aspects of the District's federal, state and local governmental and regulatory affairs as well as the District's water quality monitoring and assessment activities.

Barbara is a Vice-Chair of the South Platte Coalition for Urban River Evaluation and an active member of the Colorado Water Quality Forum and the Colorado Water Congress. She is also a member of the Board of Directors of the Regional Wastewater Treatment Authority, a cooperative effort by the Metro District, the City of Brighton, and the South Adams County Water & Sanitation District to construct a new regional wastewater treatment plant in the lower South Platte basin. She previously served on the Colorado Water and Wastewater Facilities Operator Certification Board.
