He is responsible for the operation of the Uncompahgre Project which is the largest diverter of water from the Colorado River Basin. The major features of the project include; Taylor Dam, Gunnison Tunnel, seven river diversions, and over 600 miles of canals and laterals used to serve 83,000 acres of land in Montrose and Delta Counties.

Steve has a degree in Civil Engineering from Colorado State University. He spent over 20 years working for a large construction and mining company in the western United States. Steve considers himself a farmer and returned to the Uncompahgre Valley to manage the family farm.

Steve is a fourth generation farmer in the Uncompahgre Valley, a third generation director of the Uncompahgre Water Users, and a second generation manager of the Water Users.
