

Number Eleven.

That Ditch numbered Eleven,
named "The Sabino Gallegos Ditch"

Sabino Gallegos, Tibercio Sena, Jose Leon Revora, Julian Madrid & Jose Lopez Ortiz, claimants in this matter, having been found in manner aforesaid to be a ditch for irrigation of lands and for domestic purposes, and taking its supply of water from the Alamosa River, with headgate on the north bank thereof, at a point in the S.W. 1/4 of Sec. 6, Twp 35N. R. 8. E. N. M. M., with a general course easterly, and entitled by appropriation to use of water from said river to Priority No 11, by construction thereof; and thereby to the quantity of water hereinafter mentioned, for the use aforesaid and benefit of the party or parties aforesaid; It is hereby adjudged and decreed that there be allowed to flow into said Ditch No. 11 from said river, for the use aforesaid and benefit aforesaid, under and by virtue of said appropriation by construction in Priority No 11, so much water as will flow therein on a grade of 20 feet to one mile, with five feet, with depth of water flow of two feet, computed at sixteen (16.7) cubic feet of water per second of time;

The appropriation of which water took effect on, and the Priority thereof in No 11 dates from the 15th day of April A. D. 1870.
