

Overview of the Next Update

Efforts to update the Statewide Water Supply Initiative (SWSI) have recently commenced. Outlined in Chapter 11 of Colorado's Water Plan (CWP), SWSI is an integral part of the statewide planning process. SWSI will continue to serve as an objective platform for Colorado's consumptive and non-consumptive water supply needs. SWSI is intended to work in harmony with future updates to the Basin Implementation Plans (BIPs) and the CWP.

SWSI serves as the technical foundation of the CWP and the BIPs.



Anticipated SWSI Update Schedule

The SWSI update will incorporate concepts not included in the former SWSI 2010, such as scenario planning, climate change, hydrologic variability, agricultural gap, nonconsumptive gap, BIPs, and economics.
